


**FAVORITE HOBBIES:** Wrestling, working out, and hanging out with friends.

HEAD HIGH SCHOOL VARSITY COACH

Shane has been a Head Hempfield Wrestling Coach for many years at all levels - Youth, Junior High, and now, High School. A former Head Coach at Manheim Central HS, Hershey HS, and Ithaca HS in New York, Shane wrestled at Ithaca High School where he was NY State Champion, and a HS All-American (5th HS Nationals). While at the Unicersity of Maryland, Shane was a 3x NCAA D1 Qualifier and ranked top 10 in the nation. He is a former Head Assistant Coach at the University of Maryland and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro.



ERIC NARKIEWICZ

ASSISTANT HIGH SCHOOL VARSITY COACH

This is Eric's 5th year as assistant varsity coach and his 7th overall coaching the Black Knights. Prior to joining the Hempfield staff, Eric coached at State College High School, Garden Spot High School (1 year), and Manheim Township (10 years). He graduated from Warwick High School in 1999 (3x Regional Finalist, 3x State Qualifier, State Placer during Junior Year (5th) and Senior Year (6th), 3x LL League Champion and 100 wins in three seasons). He was also the first Warwick wrestler to win the Bethlehem Holiday Tournament. "Coach Nark" wrestled at Penn State 1999-2003.




#### DON HERSHEY
